On behalf of Parliamentarians for Nuclear Non-Proliferation and Disarmament let us highlight that there is an [online Parliamentary handbook on disarmament](#) published by PNND and IPU which addresses the use of force in **cyber-space**. This online Parliamentary handbook contains a section on [Disarmament for Future Generations](#) which addresses emerging weapon technologies that could imperil the security of future generations, such as autonomous weapons systems and the **use of force in cyber-space**.

The handbook includes information on international law and processes for preventing and addressing cyber-attacks. It includes examples of national measures and parliamentary action to implement the existing international law and processes for preventing cyber-attacks.

The handbook also provides links to some detailed resources for parliamentarians on addressing cyberattacks, including the *Talin Manual* and the *ICRC Principles on Application of International Humanitarian Law in CyberSpace*.
